- Type of Activity:** Patrol Method Campout and 10 Mile Bushwack Hike (John Bryan State Park)
- Purpose of Activity:** Scouts will work on cold-weather camping and cooking skills and participate in a 10 mile hike.
- Time Schedule:** Scouts will meet at **6:00 pm on Friday, December 28** at the **Scoutmaster's House (1133 Olds Ave.)** to check and pack gear. We will depart at 6:30 pm. Please eat supper before you arrive. Scouts will return to **Mr. Marshall's House at 1:00 pm on Sunday, December 30**. Please pick up your son at this time.
- Cost of Activity:** These fees can be paid by cash, check (made out to Troop 165), or scout account at the meeting on Monday, December 17. Adult fees are the same as youth.
