Directions to Rest Stop

Take Route 23 north towards Delaware- you make the choice as to how you will get there

Exit at Waldo and take Route 98 north towards Bucyrus- Just inside the Bucyrus city limits, Route 4 will enter from the left- continue straight on 98/4

Stop for snack- in downtown Bucyrus, Business Route 30 (Mansfield Street) intersects at "The Square"- turn left and go about 1 mile- veer left at a fork in the road- elevator in the fork- Eddie Schott's Car Dealership on left- go about ½ mile- Aumiller Park is on the left

Directions to campsite

Go back to Route 98/4- take Route 4 north out of Bucyrus towards Sandusky

Continue to follow Route 4 north across the Ohio Turnpike

Head west on Route 2 across Sandusky Bay

Once across the Bay follow 269 north

Look for signs for East Harbor State Park (Group Camping Area)

Adult Information for the Lake Erie Mini-Trip

1. You are only responsible for your own personal gear. The troop has all group gear (cooking utensils, food, etc.)
2. We do not buy pop for our outings. We do have coffee, tea, and hot chocolate. If you are a pop drinker you will need to supply this for yourself. Alcoholic beverages are not appropriate for scout outings.
3. Plan to bring a lawn chair of some type. It will be your job to relax, supervise, and let the scouts do the work.
4. Please wear your troop t-shirt when we meet Saturday morning if you are not a uniformed leader. Appropriate attire would be to wear the troop t-shirt whenever the scouts are in Class A uniforms.
5. **Tents-**
 - a. All scouts will tent by patrol. If you and your son would like to tent together let Mr. Olson know as soon as possible.
 - b. We ask that use troop tents so that we look like a group.
 - c. The amount of room available in vehicles for gear is at a premium. In order to keep the number of tents transported on this campout at a minimum, adults will need to share tents.
 - d. If you have any questions about tenting, please let Mr. Olson know.
6. Arrive at 6:45 with your gas tank full. We need to depart at 7:30 to be able to make our ferry trip to the island.
