Activity Information Sheet – Feb. 7th, 2009

Type of Activity: Tour of Mead paper mill in Chillicothe, OH as a requirement for the Pulp & Paper Merit Badge.

Purpose of Activity: Mead Paper Co. has graciously volunteered to help our scouts earn their Pulp & Paper Merit Badge. Mr. Trent Graham (Glatfelter Paper – cell # 770-548-8173) has arranged for a **Mr. Tom Breeden** (cell # **740-253-4911**) to instruct us in the science of paper making and feels that we should be able to complete most or perhaps all of the requirements that day.

Time Schedule: Meet at the furniture store at **8:15 am on Saturday, February 7** we will depart at **8:30 am**. Please eat breakfast before you arrive. We are to meet Tom at **9:30 am**. We will be finished around **11:00-11:15 am**. We will eat lunch there until around **12:15 – 12:30** and the Scouts will return to the furniture store at **1:30 pm** that same day (this is a day trip). Please pick up your son at this time.

Directions: Directions from Lancaster: Take OH 159 Chillicothe Lancaster Rd SW. Follow OH 159 South. OH 159 becomes South Bridge St. / US-23 / OH-104. You'll cross the river, then in about a mile turn right onto 8th street. The mill will be on you left. The address for the research center is 232 East 8th St. There will be a guard shack on your left and a parking lot on your right. Park in the lot and meet Tom at the guard shack (Trent's directions).

Cost of Activity: There is no fee for this activity and each Scout is to bring a sack lunch.
