Type of Activity: Patrol Method Campout (Slate Run)

Purpose of Activity: Scouts will work on camping and cooking skills. New Scouts will participate in a one night campout and work on Firem'n Chit and Tot'n Chit.

Time Schedule: Older Scouts will meet at **6:00 pm on Friday, March 26** at the furniture store to check and pack gear. We will depart at 6:30 pm. Please eat supper before you arrive.

New Scouts will meet at **8:00 am on Saturday, March 27** with Mr. Heeter at the furniture store to check and pack gear. We will depart at 8:30 am. Please eat breakfast before you arrive.. Scouts will return to the furniture store at **12:00 pm on Sunday, March 28** at the furniture store. Please pick up your son at this time.

Cost of Activity: These fees can be paid by cash, check (made out to Troop 165), or scout account at the meeting on Monday, March 16. Adult fees are the same as youth.

\$16 (\$15 for meals, \$1.00 for the campsite reservation) - Meals included: Friday- snack, Saturday- breakfast, lunch, supper, snack, Sunday- breakfast. New Scouts \$11.50 (\$10.50 for meals, \$1.00 for the campsite reservation) – Meals included: Saturday lunch, dinner, snack, Sunday breakfast.

Slate Run Park & Historical Farm

1375 State Route 674 North, Canal Winchester, OH 43110 (northeastern Pickaway County)

Directions:

From I-270, take U.S. 33 east toward Lancaster to the Canal Winchester/S.R. 674 exit. Turn right onto Gender Road/S.R. 674 and go about 2 miles until it dead-ends into Lithopolis Road. Turn left and go about 1/2 mile to S.R. 674. Turn right and go about 4 miles to the entrance on the right. Once inside the park, go past the ranger station and take the first road left and follow the signs to the farm.

Slate Run Wetlands: Continue past main park entrance 1/2 mile to Marcy Road and turn right. Go 3 miles to Winchester Road and turn right. Wetlands entrance is about 2 miles on the right.
