Activity Information Sheet - October, 2009

Type of Activity: Patrol Method campout at Round Lake Christian Assembly with Canoeing on the Mohican River

Purpose of Activity: 3 to 3 ½ hour canoe trip (Mohican Valley Canoe Livery) on the Mohican River with camping at Round Lake Christian Assembly. Newer scouts will continue to work on early requirements. The buddy system will be enforced at all times. Boys who have not passed the BSA "swimmer test" must be in a canoe with an adult or a lifeguard (BSA Guide to Safe Scouting). Many scouts passed this test at last year's summer camp. Weather will be monitored by the canoe livery. The canoeing portion of the trip is weather permitting and may be cancelled by the canoe livery or the Scoutmasters if deemed unsafe.

Time Schedule: Meet Fairfield Christian Church at **6:00 pm on Friday, October 23** to check and pack gear. We will depart at 6:30 pm. Please eat supper before you arrive. Scouts will return to Fairfield Christian Church at **12:00 pm on Sunday, October 25**. Please pick up your son at this time.

Cost of Activity: **\$39 Scout / Adult** – This includes \$8 camping donation, \$19 canoeing fee, and \$12 for meals. Meals included: Friday- snack, Saturday- breakfast, supper, snack, Sunday- breakfast. **Each person is to come prepared with a sack lunch (not provided) containing all disposal items including a water bottle.**

Old tennis shoes, shorts or swim trunks, towel
Pocket knives, matches, Scout handbook, rain gear
Full Scout Uniform
Extra Change of Clothes
Mess gear and eating utensils
