**FACILITIES**-Many conveniences are provided for your comfort and recreation. A 35-acre park is located directly above the Caverns and contains a shelter house and picnic tables. A souvenir and gift shop is located within the entrance building. You will find a spirit of congeniality and wholesomeness in these pleasant surroundings. A courteous and attentive staff is at your service.

**CAVERN ENVIRONMENT**- Regardless of the weather conditions the temperature of the Ohio Caverns remains a constant 54° F. (12.2° C.) throughout the year. The air inside the Caverns is always fresh and invigorating. The tour route through the Caverns is level concrete path which will allow you to enjoy the natural beauties of the Cavern safely and conveniently. The pathway is not wide enough in several spots to accomodate the use of wheelchairs or strollers.
