Our Saturday, **Sept. 8 car wash** is approaching. Here are some important details:

The car wash will be **Sept 8 at Fairfield Christian Church from 9:00 AM -1:00 PM.** We will pre-sale tickets as well as do drive-ins. We will also have our remaining 30 mulch bags available for sale. Each boy must attend with one (or more) adult family member in order to get credit for funds into his individual scout account. Since we have a small and young troop, we plan to have parents assume the main duty of washing the cars and have the boys assist by holding posters for advertising.

**Pre-Ticket Sale:** We have scheduled ticket pre-sales on the next 2 Sundays, **Aug. 26** and **Sept 2.** We will be selling tickets at a table in the lobby of Fairfield Christian Church. In order to qualify for a percentage of funds earned during the pre-ticket sale; each scout needs to participate in at least one of the dates at FCC. Please be at FCC from **10:00 AM – 12:30 PM in class A uniform.** We will sell tickets after the first and second services. The scouts will attend the second service as a group. Parents are very welcome to attend and assist. Please plan to pick up your scout up at 12:30. Currently, we have the following scouts signed up: **Aug. 26** – Steve and John Myers. **Sept 2** – Dave and Josh Heeter, Ryan Hill, Dan and Daniel Marshall. Each scout earns money from the sales of the tickets when he participates. Helping both Sundays will earn a scout more money into his scout account. Scouts must wear class A uniform during the Pre-Ticket sales. Scouts can also take tickets home to sell to family and friends. Tickets are given for a \$5.00 minimum donation. **Mulch:** We need volunteers to transport mulch from Cyril Scott to FCC on Sept 8. We need it there by 8:30 AM.

**Day of Car Wash:** Each scout needs to attend with one working adult family member in order to earn credit into his scout account. Please bring more adult/teenager family members or friends if possible, to help wash cars. The troop is small and young, so the adults will need to assume most of the responsibility of washing the cars. The scouts need to bring a pre-made “Car Wash” poster to hold and advertise to passing cars. Scouts need to arrive no later than 8:30 AM. Scouts should be in Class B uniform for the car wash.

**\*\*\*\*\*Scouts need to bring:**

sponges, buckets, at least 5 large old towels or chamois, lawn chair, drying racks if you have one, hose and nozzle, poster with large “CAR WASH” made by scout. Each scout family is responsible to bring their own snacks, lunch, drinks, and sunscreen.
