

# Junior Leader Orientation Workshop

Planned and Conducted by Active, Trained Junior Leaders

The 22nd annual Junior Leader Orientation Workshop will be held on Saturday, March 13, 2010 at Camp Lazarus. This workshop is designed to promote and reinforce Troop Junior Leader Training, to provide information on areas of concern to Scoutmasters and updates on the latest BSA programs. We train 200 Scouts and Scouters each year. Then they go back and make the methods of Scouting work in their troops. The goal is for every troop to fully support and utilize these methods of Scouting. We have seen the improvement in those units who participate. That means better Scouting for more Scouts.

Registration will open at 7:30am in the Dining Hall at Camp Lazarus and ends at 8:00am, followed by donuts and drinks and the formation of patrols. The morning will include a general session, "**The Patrol and the Patrol Leader—Keys to Success,**" to be followed by these sessions in a round robin format (unless they have their Scoutmaster's approval to take the Leadership Class):

**Advancement in the patrol and troop  
Troop program planning and PLC meetings  
Drugs—a deadly game  
Recruiting and the new scout patrol  
Patrol meetings, organization, and administration  
Conducting super troop meetings  
Adult-scout communication**

## Advanced Leadership Class

The advanced leadership class is an opportunity for older Scouts who have been to JLOW in previous years, are 14 years or older and at least First Class rank. JLOW will offer a half day course in the morning for training SPL's and PL's and TG's. Scouts must have Scoutmaster approval. The class is limited to the first 24 students and only 2 Scouts per troop. We will cover troop leadership applications and best practices. Advanced leadership class participants must also select afternoon sessions.

## Afternoon

**All students** will attend four elective sessions selected from the lists at the right. See worksheet on the back. Adults should choose electives for the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> session. All **adults** will be registered in Session 10 from 3:00 until 4:00.

All registration will be online. Find the JLOW link at [www.skcbbsa.org/buckeye](http://www.skcbbsa.org/buckeye). This worksheet is provided for your convenience, but all registration must be completed online. Note: to register multiple scouts, keep clicking the "Add" button on the first screen after typing in each participant's name. Be sure to register all your troop's scouts and adults this way instead of one at a time to reduce the "convenience fee" when paying by credit card. (Paying by check will avoid the "convenience fee" altogether.) Signing up all at once will also help us at JLOW for registration purposes.

In order to simplify registration, please just list the email of one contact person per troop, such as one of the adults who is registered, as the email for each youth participant. We will send class confirmations to that one person in early March. When that email comes, please carefully check all name spellings for each scout so that our certificates will be printed correctly.

It is suggested that the person from each troop handling the online registration have a troop roster handy, because the online registration will ask for street address, telephone, email (please use one email for all students), troop number, and district of all those registering.

The fee will be **\$25.00** for online registrations **prior to Feb. 5, 2009** and **\$30.00** to the cutoff date of **March 1** or until the course is full at 192 participants. The fee for adults will be \$10.00. Note that a "convenience fee" will be added to all credit card payments. This fee can be reduced by registering all of the troop's scouts and adults at one time. The convenience fee can be eliminated by paying by check, but you still register online the same way. Just choose "pay by check" at the payment screen, and the "convenience fee" will be deleted. Due to limited space we will have to close registration at 192 students, so the earlier you register, the better. Afternoon sessions are first come, first served and space is limited in the most popular classes. **No walk-ins will be accepted. No refunds after March 1.** Lunch will be provided by JLOW.
